Like Brooke, from Ontario, Wisconsin

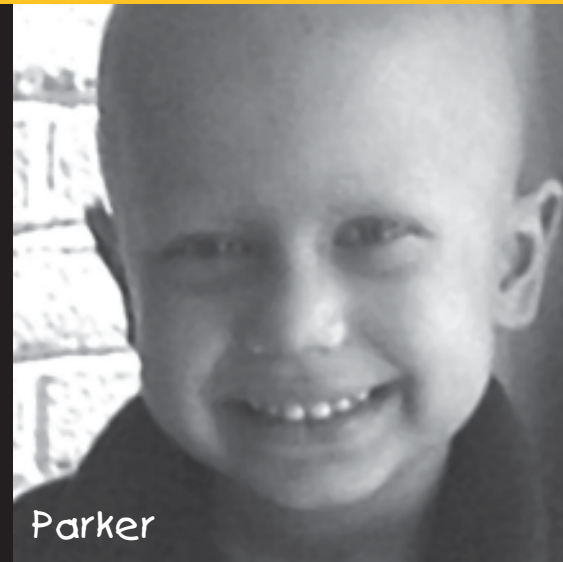
