All gifts should be unwrapped



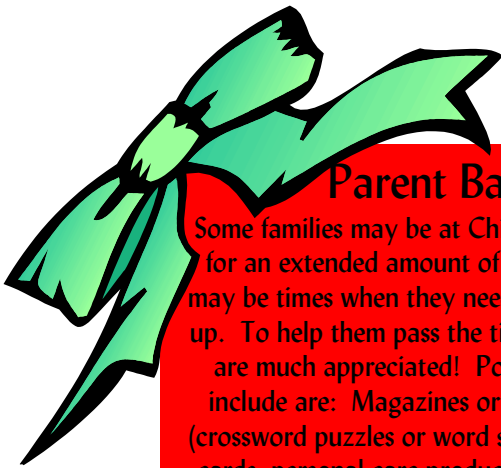
Project on the Go
